

Masters Agility Boot Camp
Presented By Geoff Nieder
Friday October 20th & Sunday October 22nd

Designed to allow competitors to run multiple AKC courses in a day, our boot camp will help students find holes in their training, and work on skills and communication with their dog.

Participants will test their skills on 4 courses per day over two days: Friday will be Standard (two masters, two premier), and Saturday will be Jumpers (two standard, two premier).

The camp will be led and instructed by Geoff Nieder, but a large part of the camp is the collaborative effort of all participants to help each team reach their highest potential. Participants will also be asked to help build each course.

Teams will get to run through each course twice. The first run will be as if the course were at a trial, followed by feedback from Geoff and fellow participants. The second run will allow the team to break down the course and work through trouble spots, with input and help from the instructor and fellow campers.

Participants should keep in mind their dog's endurance and fitness level- these will be long, but fun, days!

Location: Dog Sports At Kims

Cost:

\$200.00 per person for two days (may bring additional dog to run for \$50 extra)
\$120.00 for single day.

Priority will be given to participants wanting to do two days.

Max participants: 10 per day

Light breakfast and lunch will be provided both days. Breakfast will be available at 8, with course building starting at 8:30 both days

We will break for lunch after completion of the second course.

Teams will be allowed to work on skills and coursework as they please after completion of the courses each day.

Minimum Requirements:

Dog must be competing in Excellent/Masters AKC classes or equivalent in other venues.

Geoff has been competing in agility since 1997 with breeds ranging from Labs to Australian Shepherds to Border Collies.

Starting in ASCA agility, Geoff is now competing with Nitro, his 4 year old Border Collie, at the top levels in UKI, USDAA and AKC agility. Before Nitro turned 2 he was competing at the Masters level in AKC, winning his height class multiple times at 20, 24, and 26 inches. Nitro has been hard at work teaching his partner what it means to have running contacts and how to handle them. In 2015, Nitro attended his first USDAA regionals competition where he won the Master Challenge Standard 26" class against some of the top teams in the country, and also placed Second in Dog Agility Masters Team with teammates Jennifer McDonald and Laura Harper. In 2017, Nitro and Geoff made the finals in 26" at AKC nationals, and placed 5th in the country behind some truly stellar teams.

Geoff has worked under several different instructors, including Jennifer McDonald, Stacy Perdot, and Lori Michaels. He has a very positive and motivating training style, and pushes his students to succeed and get the best and most fun performances out of their teammates.
